WHEREAS: Since 2012, there have been nearly 1,000 facility damages in the Columbia Gas of Ohio's service territory caused by people failing to have utilities located before they dug; and

WHEREAS: Each year in Ohio, lives are endangered and property is destroyed when people fail to have underground utilities located before beginning projects that involve digging or excavation; and

WHEREAS: 811 is our state's free phone number for the general public and professional excavators to request that utilities mark the location of their underground facilities two business days prior to digging; and

WHEREAS: Recognizing that digging, in any form, near underground utilities without having them located can be extremely hazardous to people, property and the environment, the Village of McConnelsville and Columbia Gas of Ohio are working to increase public safety and prevent damages to underground facilities, ensuring the continuity of utility and communications services; and

WHEREAS: The Village of McConnelsville commits itself and its departments to call 811 before we dig, setting an example for all in the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John W. Finley, Mayor of the Village of McConnelsville, Ohio, do hereby proclaim August 11, 2015 as
