

The Kiwanis-Jaycee Community Park was built in 2005 through the collective efforts of local businesses, volunteer organizations, grants and charitable donations. Located on State Route 669 in Malta, this seventeen acre facility was developed to serve the recreational needs of Morgan County youth and houses football fields, soccer fields, playground equipment, baseball/softball fields, a concession stand, walking trail, skate board park and three full sized basketball courts. The property is jointly owned by both Malta and McConnellsville Villages. It is managed by a group of eight volunteer community members known as the "Joint Recreation Park Board", who are appointed by both Village Mayors. This tax exempt subsidiary of both Villages oversees and facilitates Park activities, maintenance and repair. We also monitor the activities of the three charitable volunteer sports organizations that help us run the park; Baseball/Softball, Soccer and Football.

The Kiwanis-Jaycee Community Park operates on a very tight budget; a \$2000 annual maintenance fee and mowing services from each Village. The economic development, public relations and youth services provided by the Park are immeasurable. The Park Board is graciously requesting volunteers and monetary donations to help sustain this valuable community resource. Upcoming projects include dusk to dawn lighting, security fencing, lighting the walking trail, a shelter house and field/court lighting.
