

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

## VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE

Resolution No. 12-30 Passed 4<sup>th</sup> day of September 2012

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE, OHIO TO ENTER INTO A LEGALLY BINDING CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY OF MORGAN, COUNTY ENGINEER TO PROVIDE FOR THE MUTUAL APPLICATION FOR BLACKTOP FUNDING THROUGH ROUND TWENTY-SEVEN OF THE STATE ISSUE ONE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY MUTUALLY WITH THE COUNTY OF MORGAN, COUNTY ENGINEER FOR STATE ISSUE ONE, ROUND TWENTY-SEVEN FUNDING FOR THE PAVING OF CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Morgan, County Engineer, the Village of McConnelsville and others are the owners of existing streets and alleys in need of blacktopping; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of McConnelsville is desirous of entering into an agreement with the County of Morgan, County Engineer to make a mutual application for funding through Round Twenty-Seven of the State Issue One Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose of funding the blacktopping of certain streets and alleys within their respective political subdivisions and whatever the other parties wish to apply for; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the interest of the public health, safety, convenience, comfort, prosperity, and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of McConnelsville to make a mutual application for the aforementioned funding with the County of Morgan, County Engineer; and

**WHEREAS**, an emergency exists affecting the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of McConnelsville.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE, IN THE STATE OF OHIO, AND THE COUNTY OF MORGAN**, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into a legally binding contract with the County of Morgan, County Engineer to make mutual application for funding through Round Twenty-Seven of the State Issue One Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of funding the blacktopping of certain streets and alleys within their respective political subdivisions and whatever the other parties wish to apply for in accordance with the terms set forth in the Mutual Issue One Funding Agreement.

**SECTION 2.** The Village Administrator is authorized to make mutual application with the County of Morgan, County Engineer for funding through Round Twenty-Seven State Issue One Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of funding the blacktopping of certain streets and alleys within their respective political subdivisions, and whatever the other parties wish to apply for.

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**SECTION 3.** The Village of McConnelville approves that the Morgan County Engineer will be lead applicant for OPWC and will permit the Morgan County Engineer to negotiate terms to obtain funding through OPWC with approval from the Village Administrator.

**SECTION 4.** An emergency existing affecting the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of McConnelville, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency resolution and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
