Resolution No. 14-38 Passed 16th day of December 2014

A RESOLUTION REDUCING THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR

WHEREAS, it is necessary to reduce the appropriations to the Sewer Design Project and the Recreation Boat Docks Capital Project due to the fact that these funds did not receive the amount of money in 2014 as originally anticipated as the projects have not been completed; or, expenses came in under the estimated amounts; reduce the appropriations to the Mayor’s Court Agency Fund as it did not bring in the amount of fine money originally anticipated for 2014.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The appropriations to the Sewer Design Capital Project be reduced by \$135,798.00 in the line item entitled Capital Outlay, (4207-800-590).

Section 2. The appropriations to the Recreational Boat Docks Project be reduced by \$2,131.63 in the line item entitled Capital Outlay, (4205-800-530).

Section 3. The appropriations to the Mayor’s Court Agency Fund be reduced by \$7,236.81 in the line item entitled Agency Fund Mayor’s Court Other, (9901-720-690).

Section 4. That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of McConnelsville, Ohio, and therefore this Resolution shall be in full force and in effect immediately after its passage.
