VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE

Resolution No. 18-26 Passed the 20th day of November 2018

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A NEW SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE MCCONNELSVILLE CEMETERY FUND FOR THE OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF A NEW CEMETERY OR THE EXPANSION OF THE EXISTING MCCONNELSVILLE CEMETERY AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of McConnelville has determined that consistent with appropriate advance financial planning, a Special Revenue Fund should be established to be used to operate, maintain, repair, and possibly expand the McConnelville Cemetery; and/or, for the development of a new Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of McConnelville has established the rates for opening and closing of graves and the sale of lots per Ordinance 18-20 to help offset these expenses;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of McConnelville desires to be in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 5705.12 which requires the Auditor of the State of Ohio to approve all funds established by a local government.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of McConnelville, Morgan County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1. The Fiscal Officer of the Village of McConnelville shall establish the following fund: 2032 – McConnelville Cemetery Fund.

Section 2. Exhibit “A” that is attached to this legislation is a request for fund approval to be sent to the State of Ohio with a copy of this Resolution; and, the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to send such request for fund approval.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were accepted in an open meeting of this Council; and, that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of McConnelville, Ohio, and therefore this Resolution shall be in full force and in effect immediately after its passage.
