VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE

Resolution No. 18-31 Passed 18th day of December 2018

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND (1000) TO THE MCCONNELSVILLE CEMETERY FUND (2032).

WHEREAS, Resolution 18-26 established a Special Revenue Fund (2032) to record and document revenues and expenditures specifically for the McConnelville Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, revenues have been received and deposited into the General Fund (1000) prior to establishment of the Special Revenue Fund know as The McConnelville Cemetery Fund (2032); and

WHEREAS, expenditures have been made for The McConnelville Cemetery out of the General Fund (1000); and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of McConnelville desires to separate these monies from the General Fund (1000);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of McConnelville, Morgan County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1. The Fiscal Officer of the Village of McConnelville shall transfer the amount of \$19,648.04, which is the balance of the cemetery monies after subtracting expenditures and encumbrances, from the General Fund (1000) into the Special Revenue Fund known as The McConnelville Cemetery Fund (2032). All future revenues received and expenditures made will be made from The McConnelville Cemetery Fund.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were accepted in an open meeting of this Council; and, that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of McConnelville, Ohio, and therefore this Resolution shall be in full force and in effect immediately after its passage.
